

Contact Hostel

Eligibility Criteria

Contact Hostel accepts referrals from:

- Young single women between the ages of 16 and 19, who are **not** violent and have **no serious** criminal convictions.
- Young single women between the ages of 16 and 19 who are pregnant. Service users have to leave the accommodation at 24 weeks pregnant
- Young women who have issues with alcohol, drugs and self-harming. **Only** if they are accessing or actively committed to accessing help as part of their support package.
- Young women in need of support and wish to benefit from that support which works towards an independent and responsible life style
- Young women who are in or actively seeking education/training
- Young women who are committed to accessing key worker support on a regular basis
- Young women who are able to share with others and can look after their own basic needs
- Young women prescribed regular medication must have the ability to self medicate **without** support from hostel staff
- Young women willing to attend and engage in house meetings and any workshops provided by the hostel
- Young women who are entitled to benefit and can produce evidence to support their claim
- Young women who have the ability and willingness to treat other service users and staff with respect
- Young women who have received a local authority assessment of housing need and are eligible for housing and are on the housing register
- Young women who at 16 and 17 years are willing to apply for and accept accommodation with other supported housing providers
